## Unemployment Rate Begins to Drop

In November, total non-farm payroll increased by 199,000 and the overall unemployment rate decreased to 3.7%. This is an increase over last month and is a result of workers returning to work after strikes.

Transportation and Warehousing lost around 5000 jobs this month and is down 61,000 people since October of 2022. Bureau of Labor Statistics December 8th, 2023
