Surprise Monthly Increase in Total Non-Farm Payroll

For March, economists predicted a rise of 200,000. The actual number was 303,000 and the unemployment rate ticked down slightly to 3.8% which is a small decrease in unemployed individuals compared to last month.

Since August of last year, the employment rate has remained steady between 3.7% and 3.9%.
